

ADVENTURE ROPES COURSE

Sky Trail

- Must be able to understand and demonstrate knowledge of all safety rules and the course environment to experience the attraction without a responsible chaperone.
- Participating while under the influence of drugs or alcohol is prohibited.
- Cell phones are NOT allowed on attraction.
- Maximum weight is 300 lbs. (136 kg).
- Maximum height is 80 inches (203 cm).
Minimum height is 42 inches (107 cm).
- Must be 48 inches (122 cm) tall to participate without a chaperone. Guests between 42 (107 cm) and 48 inches (122 cm) must have a chaperone.
- Follow all operator instructions, posted rule signs and stickers.

Sky Tykes

- Maximum height is 48 inches (122 cm) tall.
- Must be accompanied by responsible chaperone.
- Lift gates are for chaperone use only. They must be in the closed position before the participant can cross the beam.

All Courses

- Must safely fit in the harness
- Ensure that shoes are secure. No flip-flops or open heel shoes. Make sure shoelaces are tied.
- Pockets must be empty. No loose objects such as cell phones or cameras. Eyeglasses should be secure. Operators are not responsible for lost or misplaced personal items.
- No gum, food or drinks allowed on attraction.
- Only one participant on an activity at a time except if child is being assisted by responsible chaperone.
- No running, jumping, hanging in harness or horseplay. Operators reserve the right to expel participants displaying these behaviors.
- The redundant sling line should stay in front of and between shoulders at all times.
- Do not touch the overhead tracking system or tamper with harness or redundant sling line.
- No zip-lining down the stairs.
